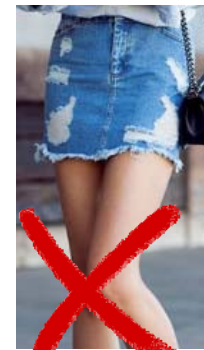


Jeans are allowed
