Dear Parents and Carers

I would like to take this opportunity to remind you of the academy's uniform policy. We have greatly appreciated your support in respect of many aspects of our students' uniform, especially in ensuring they are wearing footwear that adheres to the uniform policy.

We are, however, experiencing some challenges in respect of the length of skirts where a young person has chosen to wear one. We would like to remind you that where a student opts to wear a skirt this must be knee length and black in colour. This means skirts that are above the knee are not permitted.

A polite reminder also in respect of trousers: these must be plain black and should be tailored. Trousers must not be tight fitting to the leg. Jeans or leggings are not permitted. Socks should be black in colour and should not be trainer socks.
