## OCR Sport Science R041 Examination

I am writing to confirm that the OCR Sport Science R041 examination will take place on **Monday 10 January from 9.00 – 10.00am. This examination is part of the formal assessment of your son/daughter's Cambridge National qualification and will impact their final result.** Your son/daughter should register with their form tutor by 8.40am on Monday and then go straight to the school hall for 8.45am where they will be met by myself, the Examinations Officer and the invigilation team. They will be required to wear a face covering and bring a clear pencil case containing two black pens, a pencil, ruler, rubber, a highlighter and a calculator. All bags and personal belongings will be locked in a secure room for the entirety of the examination.

It is important that all candidates adhere to the rules and regulations of the examination; these are available to view at <https://www.icq.org.uk/wp-content/uploads/2021/08/IFC-Written Examinations 2021 v5.pdf> and will be clearly stated by the lead invigilator before the examination starts. Failure to follow the rules during the examination may result in a candidate being disqualified from the course.

To support your son/daughter with preparing for the examination we will be **holding a revision afternoon on Friday 7 January during periods four and five.** This will be led by the curriculum leader of PE, Miss T Scott and will focus on examination technique and applying knowledge of the specification to examination questions. Please ensure your child is present for the revision session and the examination session.

## Covid-19

The academy's risk assessment will be followed in order to ensure the examination room is operated in as safe a manner as possible. All students and members of staff will be required to wear a face covering for the duration of the examination unless they are exempt. The examination room will be ventilated, and students will be sat 2 meters apart.

**If your child has symptoms of Covid-19 or is required to isolate they must not attend school until they are allowed in accordance with the rules set by the government.
