May Half Term Revision Sessions 2022

Dear Parent/Carer

During the May half term holiday, we will be running revision sessions in English, Mathematics, Spanish, History and Geography. These sessions will take place on Monday 30 May and Tuesday 31 May and run from 10am - 2pm.

These sessions have been strategically placed in the middle of the examination series to offer your child further opportunities to revise key content and practise examination technique. Each session will be delivered by the subject teachers and refreshments will be provided for lunch by the academy.

Session 2 12.15pm – 2pm	Spanish	History and Geography (Students who study both can choose which to attend and will be given resources from the other subject)

In order to plan for the day, we will need to know if your child can attend the sessions. During the positive discipline lesson on Wednesday 11 May all Year 11 students will complete a Microsoft form confirming the sessions that they are able to attend.

On the day of the revision sessions, your child should arrive 10 minutes prior to the session start time. They will be met by their subject teacher and a member of the senior leadership team who will register and escort them to their session location. Students will not be required to wear school uniform; however, clothing must be appropriate and not display any offensive language/images. Hats and ripped jeans will not be permitted, and no midriiffs must be on show. As per the school's positive discipline policy, mobile phones will also not be permitted during the revision sessions. Your child should bring their planner and equipment with them so that they are fully equipped for each session. At the end of the day all students will be escorted off site.

The staff who have kindly offered their time to deliver the revision sessions in the holiday will be acting in loco parentis at all times. In the unlikely event of poor behaviour, your child will be asked to leave and contact will be made with you. I hope you will encourage your child to take full advantage of the revision sessions we are offering to help them achieve success in their subjects.
